Ogden Trust Science Partnership Announcement

This week we were told that we have been successful in our bid to become a Science Partnership School.

This means we get access to funds from the Ogden Trust to allow pupils from Copley and 4 other local schools we named in our bid, to take part in termly science activities funded by the Ogden Trust. The partnership is from September, but we are already planning the activities for the pupils. It is a 4-year programme and in Y2 we receive a grant to fully resource our Science laboratory to a really high specification. In addition, each year we get £400 of additional resources linked to a scientific theme. Year 1 for instance is sound and light.

All the teaching staff get free access to some fantastic training provided by the Ogden Trust and lucky Mrs Hemingway gets a 5-day training trip in the summer holidays to CERN in Switzerland to see the Hadron Collider amongst other things.
